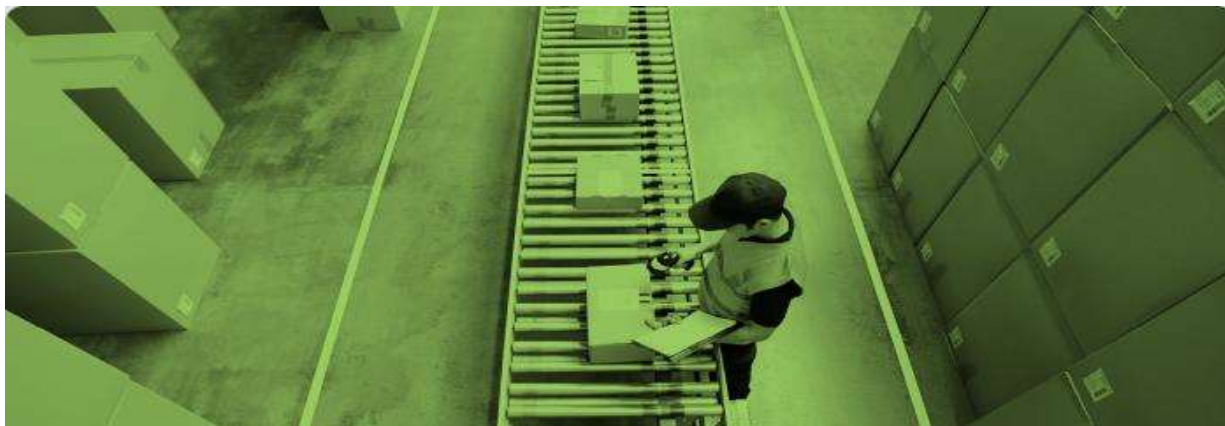

EU INVESTS €422 MILLION IN ALTERNATIVE FUELS INFRASTRUCTURE
