#### ZEV TARGETS FOR CORPORATE FLEETS: A RISK TO EUROPE'S LOGISTICS SECTOR

CLECAT reiterates its strong opposition to the introduction of zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) targets for corporate fleets, including for shippers and large transport buyers, as stated in its position paper issued last month. Representing a broad and diverse membership of companies of all sizes across freight forwarding, logistics, and customs services, we argue that such mandates risk creating market distortions, increasing operational costs, and ultimately undermining Europe's decarbonisation goals.
