# Sustainability EC ISSUES 2025 CARBON MARKET REPORT

The European Commission's 2025 Carbon Market Report, issued on 3 December, shows that maritime companies reported 89.8 million tonnes of  $\rm CO_2$  emissions for 2024, the first year the sector was included in the EU Emissions Trading System (ETS). The system now covers all emissions from voyages between EU ports and 50% of emissions from voyages to or from non-EU ports.
