Dear Member,

We would like to draw your attention to [Access2Markets](#), an extremely useful and well designed web portal developed by the European Commission-DG Trade to support businesses engaged in international trade. The platform is accessible in all EU languages, making it a valuable resource across your national membership networks.

While the portal is primarily designed with traders in mind, it contains a number of tools and resources of direct relevance to customs and logistics professionals. "[My Trade Assistant](#)" is the central tool on the homepage, allowing users to retrieve detailed information on tariffs, customs procedures, rules of origin, product requirements and trade statistics for over 140 international markets by simply entering a product HS code and country.

Of particular note for customs professionals is Rosa - the Rules of Origin Self-Assessment tool - which helps determine whether goods qualify for preferential tariff treatment under EU trade agreements. The portal also provides up-to-date regulatory and trade restriction information on export measures for specific markets, including those applicable to China and Russia. For deeper insights into EU trade agreements and their scope, you can select your country of interest under "[Non-EU Markets.](#)"

The exports of services and investment tool, within the "My Trade Assistant" menu, gives an EU company the information they need to export services and access markets beyond the EU borders. It includes resources and contacts for competent authorities in non-EU countries, with the types of services and country coverage expanding continuously.

Further tools include public procurement opportunities abroad, and a [trade barriers database](#). Users can also report new barriers through our [Single Entry Point](#) and directly access the [complaint form](#) for resolution.

The site is extremely comprehensive and, for those wishing to navigate it more effectively, the Commission has made several online [tutorials available](#). The Commission also regularly organises live online tutorial sessions for existing and future users. The next one is [scheduled for 24 March from 14:30](#). Members wishing to register can do so on this link.
